In this online summer school, the fundamentals of wealth management and the latest developments in this area – Sustainable Finance and FinTech – will be presented. You will learn the theoretical basics of portfolio management and play a simulation in which you will manage two investment funds in a group.

Sustainable Finance has emerged as a key opportunity to deploy large amounts of capital for financial returns and positive social and environmental outcome. The remaining sessions are dedicated to FinTech. FinTech is the new technology and innovation that aims to compete with traditional financial methods in the delivery of financial services.

The impact of the current situation with COVID-19 on the financial markets will also be discussed during several sessions.
